

Harman's Walk, Queen St. Southwell, Notts

Harman's Walk is our first commercial project, located in the centre of Southwell, England's smallest Cathedral town.

The development comprises a series of old shops and stables, which over the years had been cobbled together as one building. The brief was to upgrade the space, with the added attraction of creating a passage through to shops in Bull Yard behind.

The project comprises five small shops along the new passage, with two suites of offices on the first floor. The passage and shopfronts were designed to compliment the conservation area status, but with modern amenities including disabled accessibility.

A particular feature is a rooflit central area, with murals on the theme of Southwell through the seasons, created by pupils of the Lowes Wong Junior School. Since the opening of Harman's Walk, we have been involved with further

improvements to Bull Yard.
